National e-Governance Division, MeitY has developed a Learning Management System (LMS) under Capacity Building Scheme for Digital India, which caters to the needs of learning and development specially in the context of government departments.

- 2. NeGD is conducting an Online PG Diploma Programme on 'Cyber Law, Crime Investigation & Digital Forensics' in partnership with National Law Institute University, Bhopal. The course will be hosted using the NeGD Learning Management System (LMS).
- 3. The course details are as follows:

Course starts on- 02.10.2020

Duration of the course- 100 hours/9 months

Course Fee - Free of charge

Online class schedule-2/3 live classes online every week either after 6pm or on the weekends. If a trainee is unable to join any session, she/he will have access to a recorded lecture of the same and the attendance for the session shall be marked after attending the same.

Hands on training- Each enrolled trainee shall undergo an instructor led practical training session and personal contact programme at the designated cyber forensic lab for a period of two weeks.

More programme details shall be shared with all nominated officers in due course.

It is requested to nominate suitable **Group B officers** for the course as the topic is extremely relevant for the cutting-edge officers who are present in the field during the searches and deal with the digital evidence. - 5. In the event of getting more nominations than the available seats, officers who are currently serving in the intelligence wing shall be accorded priority since the course has a direct bearing on their present assignment.
