

NACIN, PALASAMUDRAM AT A GLANCE



Inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in January 2024, NACIN Palasamudram is India's flagship training campus for tax and enforcement officers. Spanning 500 acres in Andhra Pradesh's Sri Sathya Sai District, the campus blends worldclass infrastructure, immersive pedagogy, and international outreach—positioning it as a centre of excellence in public service training.

THE CHARTER

To undertake training and other capacity-building activities in the field of Customs, Indirect Taxes and Narcotics, including-

(i) Induction training of directly recruited Group A officers ;

- (ii) Specialized and periodic training for in-service officers;
- (iii) Induction training to Gr-B and C officers;

(iv) Training to State/UT and other stakeholders in the area of indirect taxation;

(v) Management and soft skills training for overall professional and personal development of officers;

(vi) International cooperation and training activities in Customs, Narcotics, and other allied areas; and

(vii) Any other capacity-building activity as may be assigned by CBIC from time to time, besides carrying out the normal administrative and establishment functions. In respect of the Centre of Excellence (CoE), it has been provided that it will undertake research work in the field of Indirect Tax and related areas.



TRAINING **ECOSYSTEM: THREE PILLARS OF CAPACITY** BUILDING

I. OFFICER TRAINEE PROGRAMMES: SHAPING TOMORROW'S LEADERS

- NACIN Palasamudram is the **national training academy for Officer Trainees of the Indian Revenue Service (Customs & Indirect Taxes)**. The academy delivers a comprehensive foundation course focused on equipping future IRS officers with the skills, knowledge, and perspective required to administer India's indirect taxation system.
- In addition to IRS(C&IT) training, the academy also conducts **specialised short-duration courses** for officers from other civil services including IRS (Income Tax), Foreign Service, Audit & Account Service, on topics such as **GST, Customs, and cross-border enforcement**.
- In-depth modules on GST, Customs, Narcotics, and international trade
- Field attachments, simulations, and inter-agency exposure
- Focus on ethics, public service, and leadership in complex governance environments

II. IN-SERVICE TRAINING & SPECIALIZED TRAINING CELL (STC)

The In-Service Training (IST) and Specialized Training Cell focus on mid-career enhancement, stakeholder engagement, and advanced domain knowledge.

CAPACITY BUILDING COMMISSION CELL (CBU)

The CBC Cell at NACIN Palasamudram was established to implement directives of the Capacity Building Commission under the National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (*Mission Karmayogi*).

The IST vertical coordinates:

- Accreditation efforts under NSCSTI
- Development of Standard Operating Procedures for training standardization
- Rollout of Annual Capacity Building Plans (ACBPs)
- Faculty development programs and decolonization of training content

As the designated WCO Regional Training Centre (RTC), NACIN Palasamudram is a trusted platform for capacity-building partnerships.

- AR/VR Learning Studio & Advanced Shooting Simulator








WORLD-CLASS INFRASTRUCTURE
