## **INDIAN TECHNICAL AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION (ITEC) PROGRAMME:**

India's external development assistance programmes in developing countries have increased significantly in their scope and coverage in the past few years. These include Lines of Credit, grant assistance, technical consultancy, disaster relief, humanitarian aid, educational scholarships and a wide range of capacity building programmes including short-term civilian and military training courses. ITEC is one of the major pillars of India's soft power Diplomacy. It has continued to strengthen in scope and outreach, with the inclusion of new partner institutions and advance courses in emerging areas such as artificial intelligence, nanotechnology, cyber security and forensics.

Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation Programme (ITEC) is the flagship programme of the Indian Government's capacity building efforts. It is a bilateral assistance programme run by the Government of India. It is a demand-driven, response-oriented programme that focuses on addressing the needs of developing countries through innovative technological cooperation between India and the partnering nation. ITEC resources have also been used for cooperation programmes conceived in regional and inter-regional context such as Economic Commission for

Africa, Commonwealth Secretariat, UNIDO, Group of 77 and G-15. In more recent years, its activities have also been associated with regional and multilateral organizations and cooperation groupings like Association of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN), Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC), Mekong-Ganga Cooperation (MGC), African Union (AU), Afro-Asian Rural Development Organization (AARDO), Pan African Parliament, Caribbean Community (CARICOM), World Trade Organization (WTO) and Indian Ocean Rim - Association for Regional Cooperation (IOR-ARC) and India-Africa Forum Summit. ITEC covers 161 countries across Asia, Africa, Latin America, Central and Eastern Europe, and several Pacific and Caribbean nations.

### **SCOPE OF ITEC:**

Assistance under ITEC covers the six areas of training for civil and defense personnel, projects and project related activities such as consultancy services, study tours, donation of equipment, deputation of Indian experts in the partner nation and aid for disaster relief. Personnel training under ITEC covers a wide and varied range of sectors such as Agriculture, Food and Fertilizer, banking, IT and computers, Cyber Technologies, AI and Emergent Technology, personnel management, Health and Yoga, Human Resource Development and Planning, Irrigation and Water Resources, Rural Development and Poverty Alleviation, Trade and International Market and administrative and scientific areas. As ITEC is demand driven, greater focus has been given to special courses, which are customized for the specific areas of training on the request of Governments of partner countries. ITEC is administered by the Ministry of External Affairs of the Government of India and all expenses including international airfare, boarding, lodging and tuition fees of selected personnel are borne by the Indian authorities.
