OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Medical Examination on first appointment.

As the Ministreis are aware, every new entrante to Government service on initial appointment is required to produce a medical certificate of fitness issued by a competent authority. Powers of the President have been delegated to the Administrative Ministries to authorise in relaxation of F.R. 10. the drawal of pay and allowances for a period not exceeding two months in respect of fresh appointment to Government service without a medical certificate of health.

- 2. In view of Government's decision on family pension communicated in Ministry of Finance (Exp) 0.M. No. 1(10)-EV(B)/78 dated 27.1.79, it has been decided that in no case should a person be allowed to join Government service in a pensionable establishment without having been medically examined and found fit.
- 3. All appointing authorities are however, advised to ensure that this does not result in delay in issuing offers of appointments to the candidates recommended by the UPSC/SSC or other bodies and that they are sent for medical examination immediately after they accept the offers of appointment.
