Sub. : Instructions on sealed cover procedure - Applicability to review DPC - clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the instructions on sealed cover procedure as contained in this Department's OM No. 22011/4/91 Estt. (A) dated 14:09.1992 and to say that a question whether the sealed cover procedure is to be followed by a Review DPC has been under consideration of this Department in the light of the decision of the Central Administrative Tribunal in certain dases. The matter has been considered in consultation with the Ministry of Law and it has been decided that the sealed cover procedure as contained in the OM dated 14.09.1992 cannot be resorted to by the Review DPC if no departmental proceedings or criminal prosecution was pending against Government servant concerned or he/she was not under suspension at the time of meeting of the original DPC or before promotion of his junior on the basis of the recommendations of the original DPC.

2. In so far as the persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned these instructions are issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
